Byng Arts Choir Audition Information for students preparing for Choir Auditions



Pre-Audition Video:

Students interested in Byng Arts Choir program should prepare a short video of *approximately* 1 *minute of singing* that demonstrates clear tone quality, breath control, and vocal range. The video can be either a standalone video of yourself at home or school, or it can be a video taken from a previous performance or recital that took place already.

Students are encouraged to choose a song that best demonstrate their vocal ability. Candidates are encouraged to choose the part of the song that showcases their voice (do not sing the entire song). The voice sample can be submitted **with or without** accompaniment in the background.

Optional: In addition to the 1 minute of singing, students are **encouraged** to speak about one or more topics listed below to include in their video:

- what makes them who they are.
- what are they passionate about; what excites them.
- describe a time and/or an event that demonstrates their ability to be a team player, and/or a leader.
- describe a time and/or event where they overcame their fear or faced a challenge.

Please do not exceed the maximum total of 5 minutes in the Pre-Audition Video
