

To apply to the **Media Arts** stream, you will need to submit *two* separate videos:

- 1) The first video(s) need(s) to be something that you have created or have had a significant role in creating. It can be any genre of video, such as: drama, comedy, music video, animation, stop-motion animation, documentary, sports action, and/or some combination of the above or something totally different. What is key is that you had a major role in creating the content. For some media forms, multiple entries are acceptable (such as short animation pieces, composite work) however the total length should NOT exceed 5 minutes (shorter video work is fine).
- 2) The second video will feature **YOU** talking directly to the camera (informal VLOG style is fine). It must be less than 60 seconds in length.

In this video you need to tell us two things:

- 1) What your challenges were in making the film(s) you submitted. That is: what you found difficult and hopefully learned from while making the submitted video(s).
- 2) What you are most proud of in these submitted film(s). The things about the video that you think are really good. Be specific.

Submit both these videos to a third-party site like YouTube or Vimeo and title them:

- "Media Arts Film Reel" with your full name in the title and
- "Media Arts Commentary" with your full name in the title.

Remember to set the permission of <u>your video as UNLISTED</u> and not Public or Private (see the following <u>link</u> for clarification).
